



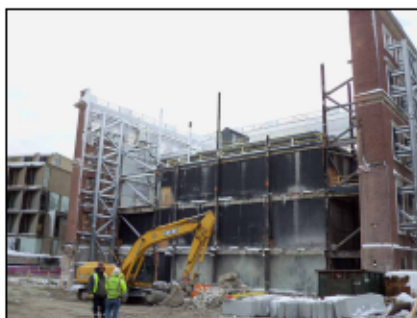

## Harvard University Art Museum



**H**arvard's Fogg Museum is the university's oldest art museum, opening in 1927. The project, which calls for the redevelopment of the site to house all three of Harvard's art museums, involves 204,000 s.f. above and below ground including the demolition of 50,000 s.f. and renovation of 104,000 s.f. NASDI worked with Skanska to achieve LEED Gold certification that involved the use of locally sourced building materials, the addition of a storm water retention tank, and state-of-the-art climate control system. NASDI demolished most of the interior of the building while maintaining its exterior brick façade and interior marble courtyard. Extensive use of shoring, bracing and selective demolition maintained the structure's historic exterior while allowing renovation.
