Shipping (equipment only)

We can assist with unloading tools up to a maximum weight of 14,000 lbs.
Anything above this weight must be arranged/handled by your team.

- Do not ship equipment using enclosed or van trailers (no loading dock)
- There will be designated trailer & truck parking available in the area. NDA volunteers will coordinate the delivery of your equipment to your designated space during move-in days.
 - All personal vehicles must be relocated to the designated parking lot by 8:00am on Thursday, March 7th.

Shipping (non-equipment)

- If you plan to ship tents, signage or any other marketing materials, please refer to the shipping labels emailed by Levy (not available in the service kit)
 - Shipments must arrive by Tuesday, February 27th in order to arrive on time.
- All exhibitor material (non-equipment) with Live DEMO labels noted above, will be delivered to the site on Monday, March 4th.
- (1) tent, signage, and other marketing materials are permitted ONLY within your company's designated area.

- All exhibitor personnel are expected to wear full PPE (including booth staff, and truck drivers) including safety-toed shoes for set-up, tear down, and the Live DEMOlition Event[™]
- Attendees are encouraged to wear safety-toed shoes, but close-toed are acceptable. PPE is required for attendees and provided on the event day.
- Daily safety briefings will take place during setup starting at 7:30 a.m.
- All on-site staff/personnel attending the Live DEMOlition Event[™] are required to attend the mandatory safety briefing onsite Thursday at 7:00am. Any of your team members not present by 7:00am will have a delayed start time for the next safety briefing.
- Everyone entering the event space (including on set up and tear down days) is required to sign the <u>safety</u> waiver and to watch the safety video (on event day)
- NDA will provide overnight security within the Live DEMOlition Event[™] area from Monday, March 4 Thursday, March 7. Please do not leave items of value in your area overnight.

- Comprehensive General Liability insurance with minimum combined single limits of \$1,000,000 for bodily injury and/or property damage in any once occurrence.

Registration

 - Additional Full Conference badges are \$975 until March 5th
